




THE DESIGN process timeline




What if...? Prompts

It also lets you think of users you may be ignoring unintentionally




What if... the product can be used on flip phones, too?

What if... the product were entirely controlled by voice?


















Finally, choosing a solution



Consider who is in the room and how they may effect the decision making process




- 1. Make sure the HIPPO does not dominate the selection process
- 2. The opposite with introverts




1. Silent voting through an app or Slack
